About ascilite



ascilite Awards

The society celebrates members' outstanding achievements in the application and implementation of technology in tertiary teaching and learning through the annual ascilite Awards Scheme. A number of awards are made each year at the annual conference. ascilite Awards are made to those entries considered by the international judging panel to be exemplary in terms of the selection criteria. The President's Award for Excellence is presented, to the one entry recognized by the judging panel as representing an advance in learning technology design, application or implementation that is of international significance.

\$2,500* Covers the cost of a President's Award trophy, framed certificates for ascilite awards and contributes to costs for the international judging panel. Sponsor receives written acknowledgement and logo in conference program and ascilite website plus speaker slot and acknowledgement at conference Awards Ceremony. Sponsors will also be acknowledged in the ascilite newsletter.

ascilite Community Mentoring Program

Community Mentoring facilitates collaboration between ascilite members through a professional mentoring relationship. ascilite Research Grants

The objectives of the Ascilite Research grant scheme are to:

Provide an opportunity for New Researchers to initiate research within the ascilite community; Provide tangible support for Early Career Researchers developing their research potential; Assist Early Career Researchers to reach national and international levels of recognition; Provide support for small projects or pilot projects likely to form the basis for a larger grant proposal; Support team research involving less experienced researchers from within the ascilite community.

\$5,000* supports one additional Early Career Researcher Grant offering a mid-career researcher grant. Sponsors receive written acknowledgement and logo in conference program and ascilite website sponsors page plus acknowledgement at recipient conference paper presentation and on all publications arising from the grant funded research.

The ascilite Annual Conference

Since ascilite was founded in 1986, the annual conference has developed a well-earned reputation as the premier opportunity for tertiary educators across Australasia to network with the international community, to share experience and generally keep up to date with trends in the education and ICT sectors. The conference provides a lively forum for engagement with top international keynote speakers, presenters of fully refereed papers, panel discussions and shorter "works in progress" as well as a variety of poster displays, workshops and trade exhibitions. It also provides memorable opportunities for social interaction.

The ASCILITE 2007 conference added to the success of events over the last 23 years, including Auckland 2002 (350 delegates), Adelaide 2003 (200 delegates), Perth 2004 (270 delegates), Brisbane 2005 (285 delegates), Sydney 2006 (380 delegates) and Singapore 2007 (250 delegates). The Melbourne conference in November 30 – December 3 2008 expects to attract between 350 and 400 delegates.

The Audience

The main target audience for the conference is tertiary sector leaders, managers, educators, ICT professionals and researchers. However, attendance records show that government departments, military academies, private training organizations and secondary and TAFE representatives also gain value from attendance. This demographic represents a niche market of consumers and decision makers. Typical attendance profiles include:

Naming rights to conference plenary session
