



National Peer Review Network Workshops

The National Peer Review Network project builds upon previously funded Office for Learning and Teaching (OLT) work and seeks to address a need among the higher education sector to meet the current standards and proposed Higher Education Standards relating to Learning Outcomes and Assessment, and Monitoring, Review and Improvement of courses of study.

Aim: These workshops aim to: (1) provide fora for sharing and disseminating good practice in **external** peer review of assessment across different contexts; (2) identify key academics experienced in **external** peer review of assessment, and (3) provide professional learning opportunities for academics and benchmarking partners.
