

Community Fellow Award Criteria

Description

The ASCILITE Community Fellow Award aims to recognise the outstanding contributions of individual ASCILITE members in the exemplary building of connections for the wider community and then into the ASCILITE community. The nature of these contributions should cover one or more of the following categories:

- Works within the community to develop professional leadership in the development, application or implementation of exemplary technology-related projects for teaching and learning in tertiary education.
- Encourages and supports the exemplary use of technologies for teaching and learning in tertiary education within the community.
- Encourages innovations in practice in the exemplary use of technologies for teaching and learning in tertiary education.
- Participating and initiating discussion in the use of technologies for teaching and learning in tertiary education in the wider community.

Conditions for Nomination

Nominations for ASCILITE Community Fellow Awards are invited from ASCILITE members. Self-nominations are accepted but they must be seconded by a current ASCILITE member. All applicants must be a current member of ASCILITE.

Award Criteria

Nominations for the ASCILITE Community Fellow Award will be assessed by a sub-committee of the ASCILITE Executive. The following criteria will guide this assessment:

1. Have made a significant contribution to a learning community in relation to:
 - a. the development, application or implementation of technology-enhanced learning and teaching in tertiary education;
 - b. the exemplary use of technologies for learning and teaching in tertiary education;
or
 - c. exemplary research into technologies for teaching and learning in tertiary education; and
2. Through their contributions have promoted the strategic vision, mission and goals of ASCILITE in a learning community.



Entitlement

The ASCILITE Community Fellow Award is a reflection of peer esteem from colleagues within the tertiary sector but has no financial benefit. The Award winner/s will be presented at the ASCILITE annual conference. There may be multiple Award recipients presented based on merit but ASCILITE recognises that there does not have to be an award presented each year. All recipients will be informed in advance of the event and would be encouraged to attend the conference in person to receive their Award. Awardees are invited to conduct an ASCILITE webinar and write a blog post during the year following their award and to present at the next ASCILITE conference. If these activities are undertaken, the awardee is eligible for a complimentary conference registration.
